**SUMMARY DESCRIPTION:**

Supervise and coordinate all new construction projects for boats and barges. Maintain good functionality of equipment keeping safety and monetary concerns in mind.

**SUPERVISION:**

Report to Vice-President of New Construction and Maintenance. Supervise all internal construction project engineers.

**ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:**

- Supervise daily activities involving new construction projects
- Assist with design and selection of new construction equipment
- Work with shipyard to build equipment to Blessey specifications
- Work with vendors to obtain necessary equipment/materials that need to be furnished by Blessey for new construction
- Ensure quality work throughout construction of each project
- Ensure that equipment will meet customer's requirements, if applicable
- Ensure that Operations, Maintenance, and Safety Departments are all in agreement with the overall product of each piece of new equipment
- Ensure that assigned project are well managed and are within assigned budget

**PHYSICAL SKILLS:**

- Be able to use a cell phone
- Be able to use a computer (MS Word, Excel, Outlook)
- Be able to perform basic computations on a calculator
- Be able to use a digital camera
- Be able to read and analyze construction drawings
- Be able to use scale rulers

### **PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- Requires walking, climbing, light lifting, seeing, hearing, and talking
- Requires being able to drive a motor vehicle

### **WORKING CONDITIONS:**

- Requires working in high, precarious places under 1/3 of time.
- Requires working near moving mechanical parts from 1/3 to 2/3 of time.
- Requires working near fumes or other airborne particles from 1/3 to 2/3 of time.
- Requires working near toxic or caustic chemicals under 1/3 of time.
- Exposed to outdoor weather conditions from 1/3 to 2/3 of time.
- Exposed to extreme heat (non-weather) under 1/3 of time.
- Exposed to risk of electrical shock under 1/3 of time.
- Exposed to vibration under 1/3 of time.

### **TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS:**

- Requires travel approximately 100-150 days per year, on average

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- High school diploma or GED equivalent
- Bachelor's degree in engineering or at least 10 years experience in maintenance of boats and barges or vessel construction
- Valid driver's license
- Good management skills
- Knowledge of AutoCAD is preferred
